# What Are Compound Words?

• A <u>compound word</u> is formed when two words are combined to make a new word. It is one of the ways in which the English language is flexible and always changing, as compound words allow people to create new words as the need arises.

# Example

The words tooth and paste are each nouns in their own right,
but if you join them together they form a new word:

#### toothpaste


• Tooth (шүд), paste (нухаш, оо) гэдэг 2 тусдаа үг ниилээд toothpaste **(шүдний оо)** гэдэг үгийг бүтээж байна.

# Example

- Black (хар)+board (самбар)=**Blackboard (Самбар)**
- Peace and war (Дайн ба энх)
- Full moon (Тэргэл сар)
- Bed+room=Bedroom (Унтлагны өрөө)
- Class+room=**Classroom (Анги)**
- Hang up (Утасны харилцуур тавих)


# Compound words

• When it comes to compound words, there are **three** different types that are important:

# Closed-Form Compound Word

- <u>Closed compound</u> words are formed when two fully independent, unique words are combined to create a new word.
- For example, you would combine "grand" and "mother" to create the closed-form word "grandmother". In a sentence, this would look like, "My grandmother is coming over." These are the most common types of compound words.

# Example:

- snowball
- mailbox
- grandmother
- railroad
- sometimes

- outside
- cannot
- skateboard
- everything
- schoolhouse

- inside
- upstream
- basketball
- anybody
- sunflower

# Open-Form Compound Word

- Open compound words are formed when two words remain separate on the page but are used together to create a new idea with a specific meaning.
- For example, "attorney" and "general" are used to form the open compound word "attorney general".

# Example:

- hot dog
- no one
- ice cream
- real estate
- high school

- living room
- sweet tooth
- grand jury
- post office
- full moon

- half sister
- cave in
- peanut butter
- Boy Scouts

# Hyphenated Compound Word

Hyphenated compound words are formed when two separate words are joined together by a hyphen.

# Example:

- two-fold
- check-in
- merry-go-round
- father-in-law
- seventy-two

- long-term
- up-to-date
- mother-in-law
- one-half
- over-the-counter
