

TO GUESS THE WORD MEANING....

1. Context

- * Other words around them
- * Near sentences

2. Meaning of STEM or PREFIX

- * Stem is a base word
- * Prefix is a first part attached to the base word.



- 1. In your own words,
- 2. Contains only the ideas of original text,
- 3. Well-planned and structured
- 4. No inserting your own opinion.

- 1. Just copied from original text
- 2. No organization and no structure
- 3. Too much unnecessary points.

Summary Writing Process

- 1. Skim-reading: Read for GIST of time, place, genre, topic, identifying unknown words.
- 2. Scan-reading: After reading the summary question and underlining its key words, return to passage and highlight the relevant material for each part of the question.
- **Select -->** only the ESSENTIAL WORs or PHRASEs
- **Exclude -->** Examples, repetitions, direct speech, figurative language and trivial details.
- 3. Transfer to plan: Transfer the highlighted material to make <u>a list of all the</u> <u>relevant points</u>, changing some of the <u>words and phrases into your own words</u> at the same time. Some technical words cannot be changed. **BUT!!!** Long phrases should NOT BE COPIED.

4. Structuring the plan:

The points in the plan should be grouped logically and reordered

- to make it possible to combine more than one point per sentence
- using brackets and arrows. This will make it possible to get all the points into a response within the word limit.

5. Writing the summary:


The summary should be in an informative style, in complex sentences (avoiding 'and'). **Check** afterwards for clarity and conclusion, and for unnecessary repetition, all of which affect the writing mark. The summary should be purely objective and without narrative, comment, introduction or conclusion.


