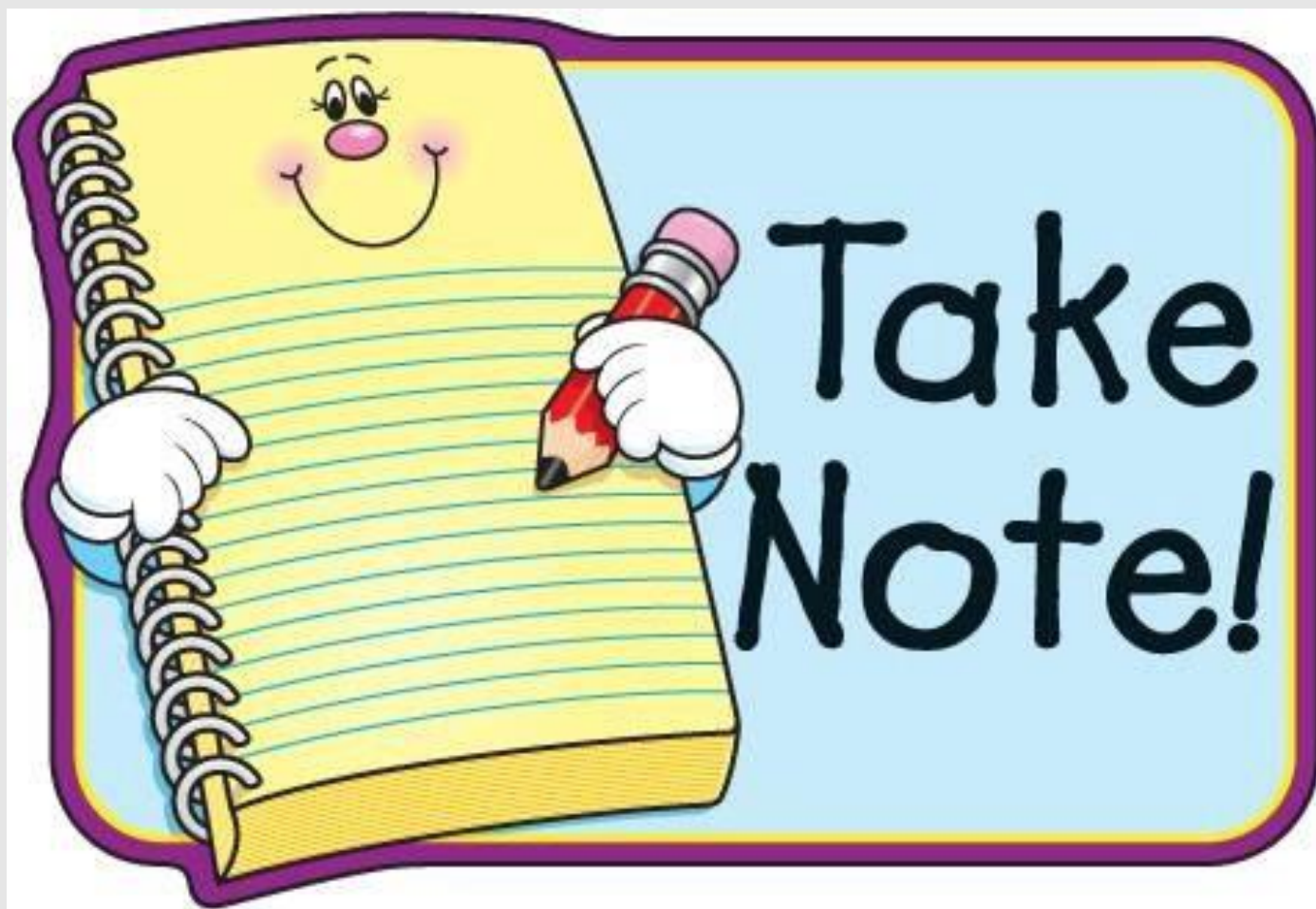




# *Unit 3. Phrasal verbs- “GET”*



# Phrasal verb- 'GET':

get away:	1) go on holiday, 2) avoid capture
get away with:	escape without being punished
get by:	survive
get down to:	start doing sth seriously
get on with:	1) have a good relationship with, <i>get along with</i> , 2) continue after an interruption
get over:	1) recover from 2) overcome
get round:	(news) spread

# Phrasal verb- 'GET':

get up to:	do
get at (someone):	criticize someone repeatedly
get rid of (something):	remove/ throw away something
get out of (doing something):	avoid something you don't want to do
get off lightly:	to experience less trouble than expected
get through to (someone):	successfully explain something
get wound up (about something):	get angry about something
