We use the present perfect to talk about experiences in the past, but we don't say exactly when they happened.

Whom do you admire?

Do you admire someone? What does that mean?



What Does the Word Mean?

Admiration-

NOUN

The respect and warm approval for someone

Example: She admired her grandmother's bravery.

Admire-

VERB

To respect someone

Example: We were just admiring his kindness.

What Does That Word Mean?:

Idol:

Noun: a person or thing that is greatly admired, loved, or revered.

Example: She is a music idol!

What Does That Word Mean?:

Hero:

Noun: a person who is admired for their courage, etc.

Example: That person is a real war hero!
