for the exclusive manufacturing and marketing rights of the Biro ballpoint for the North American market. "Eversharp" were slow to put their pen into production, however, and this delay cost them their competitive advantage.

Meanwhile, in June 1945 an American named Milton Reynolds stumbled upon the Biro pen while on vacation in Buenos Aires. Immediately seeing its commercial potential, he bought several pens and returned to Chicago, where he discovered that Loud's original 1888 patent had long since expired, and he therefore wasted no time making a copy based on the biro design. Establishing his pen company with just \$26,000, Reynolds quickly set up a factory with 300 workers who began production on 6th October 1945, stamping out pens from aluminum. Just 23 days later, the Reynolds' ballpoint pen caused the stampede and Gimbels Department Store. It was a huge success. "Eversharp" company challenged Reynolds in the court laws, but lost the case because the Biro brothers had failed to secure a U.S. patent on their invention.


