## Present Simple



### Present Continuous

#### Present Simple OR Present Continuous

- 1. She always takes the bus to school.
- 2. Mammals feed their babies on milk.
- 3. Tim is doing the dishes at the moment.
- 4. The last train to London leaves at 9:15pm.
- 5. We are going to the opera next Saturday.
- 6. The hole in the ozone layer is becoming bigger and bigger.
- 7. Water freezes at 0'c.
- 8. You're always leaving your newspaper on the floor.

## We use **PRESENT SIMPLE** for:

- 1. Permanent state, repeated actions or habits
- 2. General truth and laws of nature
- 3. Timetables (of planes, trains, etc)
- 4. Sports commentaries, reviews and narration.

Formula: S + V + O

Time expressions:

Usually, often, always
Everyday/week/month/year
In the morning/afternoon/evening
At night/the weekend
On Mondays/Tuesdays etc....

### We use **PRESENT CONTINUOUS** for:

- 1. Actions happening at the moment of speaking.
- 2. Fixed arrangements in the near future (when the time and place have been decided)
- 3. Situations which are changing during the present time.
- 4. Frequently repeated actions, to express annoyance. (always, constantly, continuously)


Formula: S + (TOBE +Ving) + O
Time expressions:

Now, at the moment, at present These days, still, nowadays Today, tonight etc.....

#### PRESENT SIMPLE

- 1. Permanent state, repeated actions or habits

Admit defeat or that one cannot do sth

#### GIVE OUT

- 1. Give freely,
- 2. Come to an end,
- 3. Emit

#### GIVE UP

- 1. Stop,
- 2. Decide that one cannot do sth and stop trying.
