Present Simple OR Present Continuous

1. She always takes the bus to school.
2. Mammals feed their babies on milk.

Everyday/week/month/year

In the morning/afternoon/evening

At night/the weekend

On Mondays/Tuesdays etc....

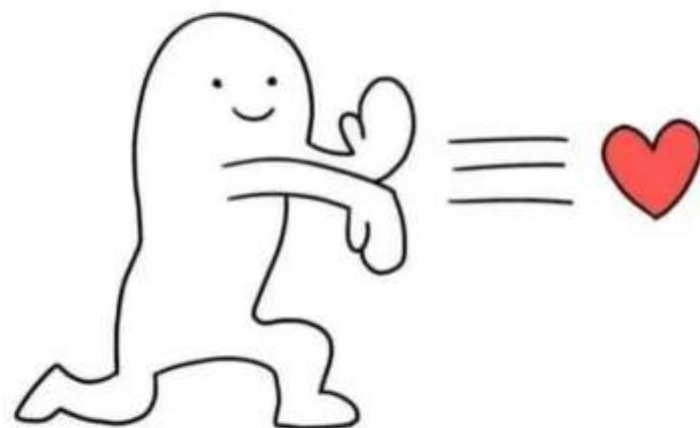
